I listen

I challenge

We bear witness to the things we love. We speak to others about the movies and books we love. We wear colours of our sporting teams and goofy designer logos. We used to share music albums.

We witness to the things we love and guide people to appreciate things that impact us in profound ways.

We conclude this week of reflections by pondering, the purpose of the Holy Spirit's guidance in our lives.

Why should we be guided to change, to express certain gifts?

I recall working with a gentleman as a hotel cleaner. I've never quite figured out why we were always paired together; we were pretty slow workers comparatively. But alas, we were, more often than not working together. The real part of the story however is that there was something about this man I could never put my finger on. Something different. Something beautiful. Something fascinating. And, a little mysterious.

Interestingly there is little else I recall about him, not even his name, just that there was something different.

I had this conversation with a staff member after he left the position. He seemed to go as inconspicuously as he came. But I said there was something different about him. Then we realised it was his faith. He truly was a light that drew people into wanting to know what it was that he had and whether he could share it.

Now I could have asked all sorts of things. Spiritually I wasn't ready. But the presence of this man, the gifts he shared that I had no language for, removed scales from my eyes, hardness of my mind and I would begin to seek what it was that he had.

God has revealed and shared of himself, that we should know him by the persons of the Holy Three. God has invited us into this relationship, to experience a connection to him. So much so that we have the Holy Spirit breathed on and in us that we should always be in intimate communion with Jesus Christ. Recalling that if you have seen me (Jesus), then you have seen the Father. I knew something was different in this man, now I know it was Jesus.

As God has not kept himself from us, the Holy Spirit's guidance is not for us to keep to ourselves (not that it is ours to give or receive). But as guide, and as fruit, we cannot help but share the knowledge of Jesus Christ as our redeemer through expressions of Spiritual gifts.

For those who have received the Holy Spirit, we guide others to Jesus Christ by the Spirits witness.
